Intertek Warns of Safety Concern for on LocknCharge Technology Charging Stations

Published: October 11, 2017 – Updated March 18, 2019

The following is a notification from Intertek that the LocknCharge Technology Charging Stations LNC iQN, identified may represent a safety concern. This notice supersedes prior versions.

Product Description	The CPSC recall involves LocknCharge iQ10 charging stations that allow users to charge and store multiple tablet computers.
Manufacturer	LocknCharge Technologies LLC, of Madison, Wis.
Number of Units	About 550
Identification	The charging stations are metal cubes about 16 inches tall x about 16 inches wide x about 12 inches long and have two doors on the front. The cube has white sides with black doors and either a black or white top cover. The LocknCharge logo is on the sides of the cube. The charging stations came with a blue basket and a green basket with dividers that hold the devices to be charged. The baskets have a white handle with the LocknCharge logo on each side. The charging stations have two USB charging hubs under the top cover.
Reported Hazards	Defective USB charging hub under the top cover which have no batch code or that have batch codes that begin with 14L, 15B or 15C can cause an electrical shock to the consumer when the charging station is connected to the electrical supply. Batch codes can be found under the silver label as shown on in the photographs.
Sold at	Distributors to schools, government agencies and other users from February 2015 to May 2015 for about \$600.
